The Forever Fund

Securing the Foundation's Future

The Board of The Community Foundation recently renamed our Operating Endowment Fund, the Forever Fund. The Board selected this name because the operating endowment secures the operations of the Foundation FOREVER.

The Forever Fund's intent is to secure the Foundation's future by building a permanent endowment that provides an annual source of income. Each year, 5% of the fund

balance is utilized to support the Foundation's operating budget. The more the Foundation is able to draw out of the Forever Fund, the less the Foundation relies on monies raised at our annual fundraising events. Right now we

are supplementing our expenses with dollars raised at our Key Event and Community Golf Classic. It is imperative that we reach our goal for the Forever Fund so that all dollars raised at Community Foundation Fundraisers will benefit, dollar for dollar, the Community Grant Fund.

The Foundation is beginning its final phase of the Forever Fund Campaign. By December 31, 2009, it is our intent to secure a \$5M Forever Fund that will support the operations of our Foundation into perpetuity. We thank the Founding Families, Founding Businesses and other Forever Fund supporters for their financial leadership and vision of the Foundation. Their commitment has enabled the Foundation to offer outstanding service to our donors, local non-profits and community partners. Together, we will continue to strengthen the heart of our community and focus our efforts on fulfilling our philanthropic mission.

Community Grant Fund

Striving to Improve our Community

The Foundation's Community Grant Fund awards grants to local charities. Non-profits who are providing service or would like to expand their service to our area are encouraged to apply for grant funds.

In 2007, the following organizations received grant awards from the Community Grant Fund:

Big Brothers/Big Sisters - \$5,000
Lakota One to One Mentoring Program



Funding of this project expands the site based mentoring program that trains new mentors for students in West Chester and Liberty Township. The program provides a positive difference in the lives of children through professionally supported one-to-one relationships with an adult volunteer. In addition to working with students to increase their self-esteem and develop new skills, volunteers provide tutoring and other academic support.

People Working Cooperatively - \$5,000
Emergency Home Repairs

This grant provides funds to offset the costs of essential home repairs for low-income residents in West Chester and Liberty Townships. Repairs are made to homes that threaten the immediate health and well-being of the resident or the structural integrity of their home. The repairs allow for citizens to remain safe and independent in their own surroundings.

Reach-Out Lakota - \$5,000
Hydraulic Lift

Support was provided to purchase a hydraulic lift that will allow volunteers the ability to increase their productivity in sorting and organizing the generous donations from the community.

S.E.L.F. - \$5,000
Project 2 Empower

This grant was awarded to enhance the program that continues to link individuals and families with the skills and resources that encourages them to become more self-sufficient. The program strengthens a family's ability to withstand stress while working to improve their economic stability. Participants develop an individualized service plan that sets financial, emotional and physical goals.

West Chester Historical Society - \$2,500
Station Road School House Renovation Project

The West Chester Township Historical Society leveraged their donation from the Foundation and other supporters to renovate the Station Road Schoolhouse. Foundation support was earmarked to off-set the cost for materials to restore the windows of the historic schoolhouse.



West Chester Police Department - \$1,000
Hooked on Fishing, Not on Drugs

The West Chester Police Department invites youth from the Lakota School District to participate in an outdoor activity with police officers. While teaching them the sport of fishing, the officers discuss the dangers of drugs, alcohol and delinquent behaviors with the students. Funds are used to support the purchase of fishing gear.



Good Things Happening

Charitable Dollars at Work in the Community

While the Foundation's Grant Committee oversees grants awarded from our Community Grant Fund, we have more than 84 other funds at work in the community. These charitable dollars quite possibly would not be happening if it weren't for the direction and leadership of The Foundation. Because we make it easy to be charitable, more and more donors are starting their own funds and carrying out their own charitable dreams. These dollars are used throughout the year to support good things happening both in our community and across the country. In 2007 alone, \$236,425.00 was awarded from our Donors' funds. A few examples follow...

Power of the Purse

The Power of the Purse Fund, a giving circle to benefit causes important to women, awarded its first annual grant in 2007. The Fund awarded \$10,000 to Girls on the Run, a non-profit organization that encourages pre-teen girls to develop self-respect and healthy lifestyles through running. The grant will develop a program in Lakota Schools.



Angel Fund

The family of Christopher Moon was devastated when Christopher, at the age of 21, lost his battle with Hodgkin's disease on the day before Thanksgiving, 2007. At the onset of his illness, Christopher was a promising student on a full ride scholarship at Wittenburg. During the three years of his illness, Christopher's family cared for him in their home.

The Moon's had planned to take Christopher on a Cruise in December. However, his untimely death put an end to those plans. The cruise was already paid for...so the family decided they would use the trip as a time of grieving and healing.

During the extended illness, not only had a toll been taken on the family, but also on the Moon's home. Friends and family of Christopher, eager to provide loving support in whatever way they could, decided to freshen up the Moon's home while the family was on the cruise, surprising them upon their return. This enthusiastic group contacted the Foundation's Angel Fund to request funding for this charitable project. The Angel Fund stepped in to offer financial support. Area businesses were approached and some simply donated the items necessary to help in this makeover while others gave deep discounts...all leveraging the Angel Fund grant support. In just one week, with the determination and passion of all involved, the home makeover was complete!

Types of Funds

Several Options to Fit Your Unique Needs

The Foundation offers donors a variety of fund options for individuals, families, businesses and nonprofit organizations alike. Our personalized service offers efficient and flexible ways for donors to give back to the West Chester/Liberty community as well as nationwide. Our staff works closely with each donor to assist them in selecting the right vehicle to meet their charitable goals. Each fundholder can determine how much or how little they want to be involved with their charitable giving. Funds can be created using assets such as cash, stock, securities, real estate, life insurance or private foundation assets. Contact the Foundation's professional staff to discuss how you can create a fund of your own, today.

Community Grant Fund enables donors to make charitable gifts for the benefit of the entire community. The Community Grant Fund allows the Foundation to respond quickly to pressing community needs. Grants are recommended by the Foundation's Community Grant Committee with approval by the Board of Directors to organizations and initiatives that enhance the quality of life in West Chester/Liberty.

The **Forever Fund** is The Community Foundation's very own endowed fund. The income earned from investing this fund is used to pay the operating expenses of The Foundation. Building this endowment assures the longevity of The Community Foundation forever.

Agency Endowments are established by an organization to support the mission and goals of their non-profit agency. These funds help create a steady stream of income for their operations, programming and other organizational needs.

Donor Advised Funds provide an opportunity for donors to recommend distributions to specific charities at their convenience. These funds allow the donor to combine income tax planning with charitable giving. Donors obtain an income tax deduction for the value of appreciated assets when making a gift to their Donor Advised Fund at the Foundation. Later, they can recommend the charities to whom they wish to grant the funds. A Donor Advised Fund is similar to having your own private foundation...without the legal fees and excise tax payments.

Designated Funds provide support to a donor's favorite charity. These funds create an endowment to support organizations long-term.

Field of Interest Funds are the perfect choice for donors who wish to support a geographic area of their choice or a particular interest, such as, the arts, environment, or children.

Scholarship Funds provide an opportunity to help students achieve their educational goals. Scholarship funds can be designed for any level of education from pre-school to post-graduate work. Donors may designate particular eligibility requirements, field of study, or a specific geographic area.

Deferred Gifts allow donors to leave a charitable legacy. Three of the most common types of deferred funds include bequests, charitable remainder trusts and life insurance policies. Our staff would be happy to discuss the benefits of these contributions with you.

In honor of their 64th wedding anniversary, the family of William and LaVerne Stautberg presented the couple with a donor advised fund held in their name at The Community Foundation. The Fund, started with gifts from their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren, will ensure their legacy by presenting charitable gifts to the initiatives and charities the Stautbergs supported during their life together. The grants will be awarded annually on June 19th, their wedding anniversary. The gift was presented to the couple just days before William passed away after a courageous battle with cancer.

Even with raising eight children, the Stautbergs were early philanthropists... giving generously of their time and talents to their community. They often gave of themselves to their church, schools and civic organizations like the Kiwanis and Santa Maria. Around the time the Stautbergs celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary, William expressed an interest in creating an endowed charitable fund. The Stautbergs understood the power of endowment and often talked about their desire to create a fund that would give their family the opportunity to leave a legacy while at the same time teach their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren the importance of giving back to their community. However, it was not until the family met with The Community Foundation that the family felt secure in helping Mr. Stautberg realize his dream.

The establishment of the William A. and LaVerne R. Stautberg Fund captures their spirit of giving and enables the children and grandchildren of this marvelous couple to share in and continue the service that was such an important part of their lives.

Each year, named organizations selected by William and LaVerne will receive a grant in their name. In addition, the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren will be able to follow in William and Laverne's footsteps by nominating and voting on one additional grant to a charity of their choice. Getting the entire family involved in the process creates an intentional focus on philanthropy that teaches the power of giving back to the community.



The Heroes' Fund

Financial Relief For Returning Military Personnel In Need

The Heroes' Fund has been established to provide one time financial support for any military family, current or honorably discharged, whose primary breadwinner has served in a combat zone or, if the serviceman/woman is unmarried, to the parents or family members with whom he/she resides and to provide grants to various veteran's non-profit organizations. This fund is available to qualified persons residing in Butler, Warren, Hamilton, Clermont and Montgomery Counties or to non-profits serving this group of qualified residents. This fund is not to be used for scholarship purposes. Qualified applicants must complete The Heroes' Fund application form to be eligible.

"It is unfathomable to me that our servicemen and women, who are protecting and defending our freedom, would be saddled with the financial worries and stress that many are incurring. This fund offers financial relief to those Heroes and their families, and I am grateful to anyone who supports The Heroes' Fund," says Chris Wunnenberg, Veteran and Advisory Board Co-Chair.

The first gift of more than \$4,000 was awarded from the Fund to a returning Hero who was wounded in Iraq and sent home to have surgery and recuperate before returning to the front. Because of his change of status in active duty, the paychecks had not made it through the red tape in a timely manner. He was behind in his house

payment, utilities and credit cards. He was receiving help from his church with food and incidentals, but it just wasn't enough. He is a proud young man who shouldn't have to worry and be stressed about how he was going to pay his bills and provide for his wife and three young children. He was always clear about how the Government pay would eventually catch up to him, but at that moment, he didn't know where to turn. The Heroes' Fund stepped in....and the following is taken from his thank you note...

"...One thing I tell my 3 boys is that Heroes come in all shapes, sizes and colors, not just sports. A Hero, to me, is more action than words. You and your staff said you would help and you DID! It is an honor to have met you all. God Bless and God Speed."

This is only the beginning of The Heroes' Fund working miracles in the lives of our returning men and women in the five-county area. If you know of a hardship case in our area, please point them in the direction of The Heroes' Fund.

Youth in Philanthropy (YIP) Fund

The Inaugural Class Graduates

Four years ago during the 2004-2005 school year, The Foundation recruited its first class of advisors for the Youth in Philanthropy (YIP) Fund. The program was created to introduce

our community's most important asset, our youth, to philanthropy and community development. The program provides hands-on experience for up to 30 local teens and benefits both the participating students as well as local charities. The YIP students learn how to raise money, build endowment funds and make grants from their earnings to non-profit organizations. Since the program was initiated, the students have granted more than \$14,000 (money raised directly by them) to various initiatives important to youth.

In 2008, the inaugural freshman class will graduate. Their leadership has been instrumental in defining the role and expectations of the YIP Advisors. During their four years, the students have not only developed a grantmaking process, but they have completed a needs assessment of their peers, implemented an annual fundraiser, volunteered their time to local charities and began a relationship with the administrators in the Lakota School District to host Rachel's Challenge, a program designed to enhance compassion and respect in the school. In recognition of their grant to bring Rachel's Challenge to our community, YIP was awarded the Great Grant Award from the Council on Michigan Foundation's. The Award is given annually to youth driven programs working to improve their community. These accomplishments have advanced the YIP Program into an initiative of the Foundation that will continue to expand and improve the lives of young people in our community for many years to come.

Organizing Families Charitable Giving

Given that their children were raised in West Chester, it was important to the Roberts that a portion of their charitable giving be used to support the West Chester/Liberty community. They chose The Community Foundation of West Chester/Liberty to be their partner, their vehicle, to assist the family in giving back to their community. The Roberts trusted the Foundation's insight on the specific needs in West Chester and surrounding communities. Therefore, it made a lot of sense for the family to set up a donor advised fund within the Foundation.

Criteria were established, a selection committee was formed and donations were secured. “The Foundation made it easy for us to set up a scholarship fund in our daughter’s name. The Fund will allow Julia’s legacy to live on and on,” said Tim. “The Foundation has given us the opportunity to support others as they further their education on a path to reaching their dreams.” In 2008, Tim and Stephany will award the first of many, annual Julia Ellen Burnett Scholarships to a high school senior pursuing his/her dreams.
